DIRECTIONS

InStride Therapy is located off I-75 Exit 195 (Laurel Road).

From I-75: Proceed West on Laurel Road to 3rd Traffic Light (Mission Valley Blvd.)

Turn Right on Mission Valley Blvd.

From US 41: Proceed East on Laurel Road to 2nd Traffic Light (Mission Valley Blvd.)

Turn Left on Mission Valley Blvd.

Travel on Mission Valley Blvd for one mile. Turn left into Calusa Lakes (large rock waterfall in entrance). Pass the security gatehouse and take immediate right. (continuation of Calusa Lakes Blvd.) and travel on this winding residential road.

NARHA Instructor Certification Process

NARHA offers three levels of Instructor Certification for therapeutic riding: Registered, Advanced and Master. The focus of this workshop/certification is the Registered Level.

In order to become a NARHA Registered Instructor, you must successfully complete two phases of the certification process. For additional information on this process, please refer to the NARHA website at www.narha.org under *Instructor Certification* drop down menu. Any questions that you have regarding Phase One should be directed to the NARHA office, with all questions regarding Phase Two directed to Three Gaits or the NARHA office.

Phase One (NARHA)

With the submission of your Registered Instructor Certification Application Form, a \$55 application fee, copies of current CPR and First Aid certification cards, and NARHA membership number or membership application (\$45 membership fee) to the NARHA office, you will officially enter into Phase One. Upon receipt, NARHA will email you a Phase One Packet. This packet includes access to the following online components:

- Center Accreditation Training Course (CAT)
- CAT Instructor CAT Exam
- Instructor Self Study Course
- NARHA Registered Instructor Open Book Exam

Note: Candidates have **six months** to complete the Phase One Packet. Please note the CAT Course/Instructor CAT Exam has a 60 day time frame and the Instructor Self-Study Course/Instructor Open Book Exam has a 6 month time frame.

Upon successful completion of Phase One you will receive a confirmation of Instructor-In-Training status letter from the NARHA office. At this point you are considered an Instructor-In-Training. You may retain this designation for twelve months from the date of your confirmation letter.

Phase Two (InStride)

Within the twelve month timeframe, you must have completed all the components of Phase Two. These components are:

- Complete **25 hours of practice teaching mounted therapeutic riding lessons** under the guidance or direct supervision of a NARHA Certified Instructor.
- Attend a **Registered Instructor On-Site Workshop**. You must attend a workshop prior to the certification component.
- Successfully complete a **Registered Instructor On-Site Certification**.

If you are interested in attending the On-Site Workshop and/or Certification please complete the attached form and mail with appropriate fees to InStride. You will also need to include a copy of your confirmation of Instructor-In-Training status letter from Phase One if registering for certification. Candidates are registered on a first come-first served basis, so make sure to register early. *All certification candidates must register for the OSWC by December 1, 2010.*

Once registered for the workshop and/or certification, InStride will send you a Phase Two Packet. The packet will include the following information:

- On-Site Registration Form
- Emergency Medical Treatment, Liability and Confidentiality Forms

Additional forms for certification candidates:

- Instructor resume, personal reference, professional reference, and essay questions
- Documentation of Teaching Hours Form

You will need to complete the Phase Two Packet and return to InStride with a copy of your NARHA membership card, and current copies of your CPR and First Aid certification. All Phase Two Forms must be returned to InStride by December 1, 2010.
